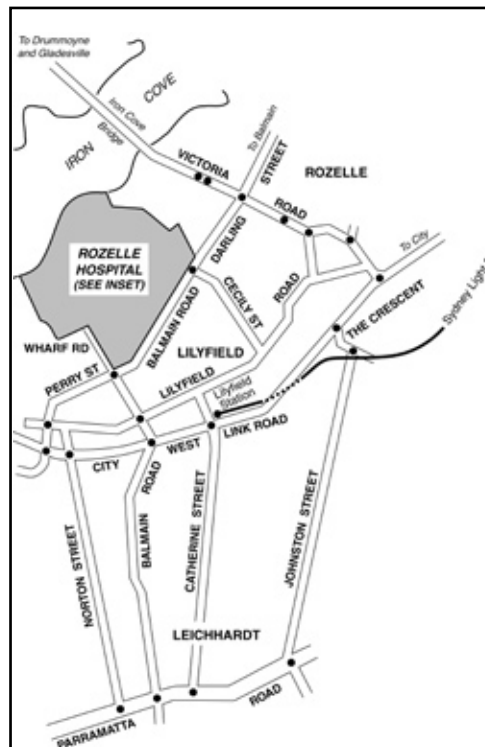
Well-known artist performances based on historical and contemporary themes of Eureka including:
